Information:

Start: Registration starts at 12:15 and singing starts promptly at 13:00

The venue is All Saints' Church in Sutton Courtenay, OX14 4AE, a beautiful 12th century building in a delightful setting. We expect to be seating people on wooden pews. These all have seat cushions, but you would be welcome to bring extra cushions if you wish.

Performance: This takes place from 17:00 to 19:00 in the church. There is no charge, but we are happy to accept donations from audience members.

Parking: Parking is limited so if you can share a car it would help. Access is from The Green – there is no vehicular access to All Saints' Lane behind the church. Parking in front of the church itself will, where possible, be reserved for disabled parking. There is a small car park at the south end of The Green and the Abbey had kindly given us permission to use their grounds for parking. Access to the Abbey is through a gateway at the south end of The Green – pull onto the ground to the right of the road leading to the Abbey. There are no restrictions to parking on the main road itself but please park sensibly.

Refreshments: we will provide tea or coffee and cake at about 16:30.

Lunch: The possibilities for brunch or an early lunch in Sutton Courtenay include:

- **Community Brunch** – the Church is putting on a Community Brunch between 9:30 and 11:30 on the morning of 3rd October. This is in the River Room which is adjacent to the church. If you want to partake of this please let us know - secretary@suttoncourtenaysingers.org. It is a small venture, and the helpers need to be prepared for an influx. There is no charge, but a donation to cover costs is welcome.
- **The Abbey** has a café open on Saturday mornings between 10:00 and 14:00 and serves cakes and light brunch. [Abbey Café – The Abbey](#)
- **The Swan** is about 3 minutes' walk from the church and offers lunches [HOME | theswanfoodhouse](#)
